The Financial Crisis and the Public Sector

Dear Colleagues:

The 16th Symposium on Public Economics will be held on 5 & 6 February in Granada. The Symposium will take place in two types of sessions:

-Sessions dedicated to the Symposium's monographic topic:
"The Financial Crisis and the Treasury"

-Open sessions dedicated to the presentation of papers on any hypothesis or practical topic in the field of Public Economics.

We invite any researchers who work on related fields to submit their papers for the coming Symposium. The presentations will be organized into parallel sessions. Each one will be allocated around 20 minutes and will be submitted to the opinion of a commentator. Each presentation may also be discussed for around 5 minutes by those attending. The Organizing Committee will assign the commentators according to the criteria of equality and closeness between the fields of research.

The papers will be submitted digitally via the Conference Maker on the Symposium website (<http://www.economiapublica.es/>), before 31 October next. Each paper will be sent as a single PDF document weighing no more than 3MB. The Website will not accept other formats. An author or authors may send more than one paper.

Whether or not you contribute a paper, you may take part in the Symposium as a commentator by sending an email to that effect to: info@economiapublica.es. The deadline is 31 October 2008.

On 22 December, the Scientific Committee will notify you whether or not your paper has been accepted.

Warning: Accepted papers will only be included in the final programme only if the author(s) registered before 16 January.

Papers accepted after assessment by the Scientific Committee will be distributed via the Conference Maker to those who attend the Symposium.
